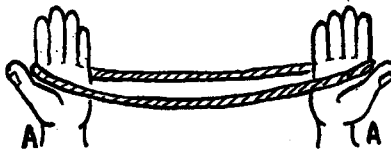
1. Animals, birds and fish important to people of the West Coast cultures have been drawn in the style of West Coast Indians. Name the the animal bird or fish that each drawing represents.
2. *Without tracing*, use the worksheet as a guide in making your own larger drawing. You can draw one animal or combine two or more animals. Drawings must be coloured.



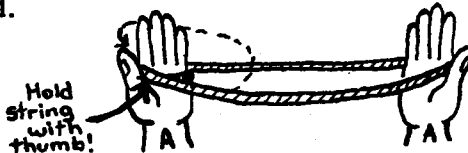
CAT'S CRADLE - STRING GAMES

Step #1 The Cat's Cradle

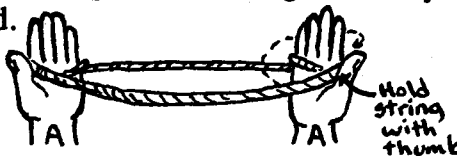
Tie a 150 cm long piece of yarn in a loop and place the yarn over partners A's hands.



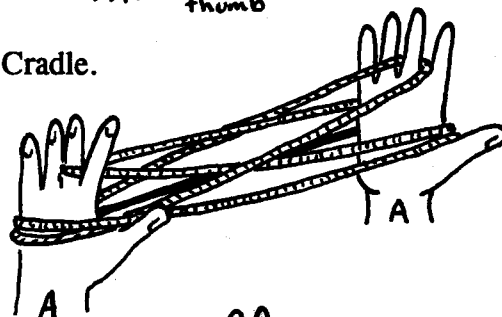
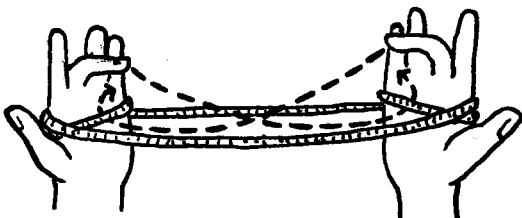
Use the thumb and index finger of your right hand to pinch the string close to your left hand. Wrap the string around your left hand.



Use the thumb and index finger of your left hand to pinch the string close to your right hand. Wrap the string around your right hand.

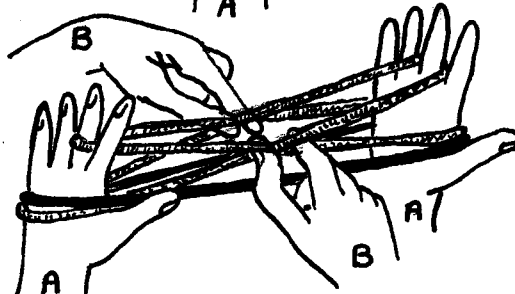


Slide your middle fingers under the loops to finish the Cat's Cradle.

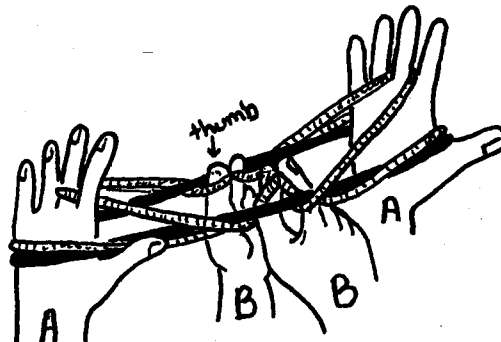
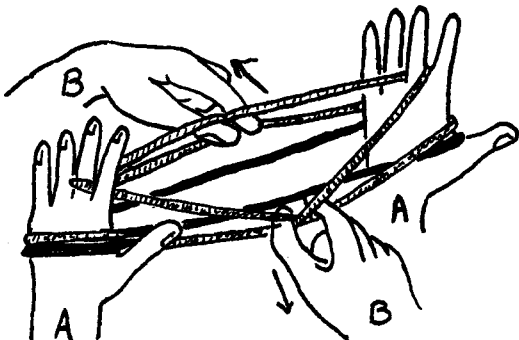


Step #2 - Making The Bed

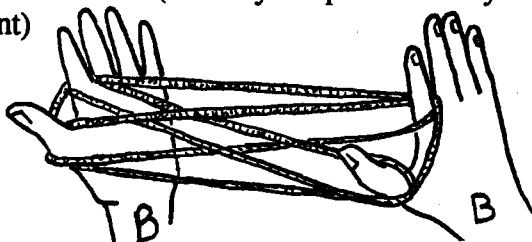
Partner B pinches the strings with thumbs and index fingers where they make an X.



Pull the X's out to the sides and then down and under the outside strings.



Partner B moves hands apart and the bed is made. (When your parents tell you to "Make your bed!" this is probably *not* what they want)
