Canada's communities.



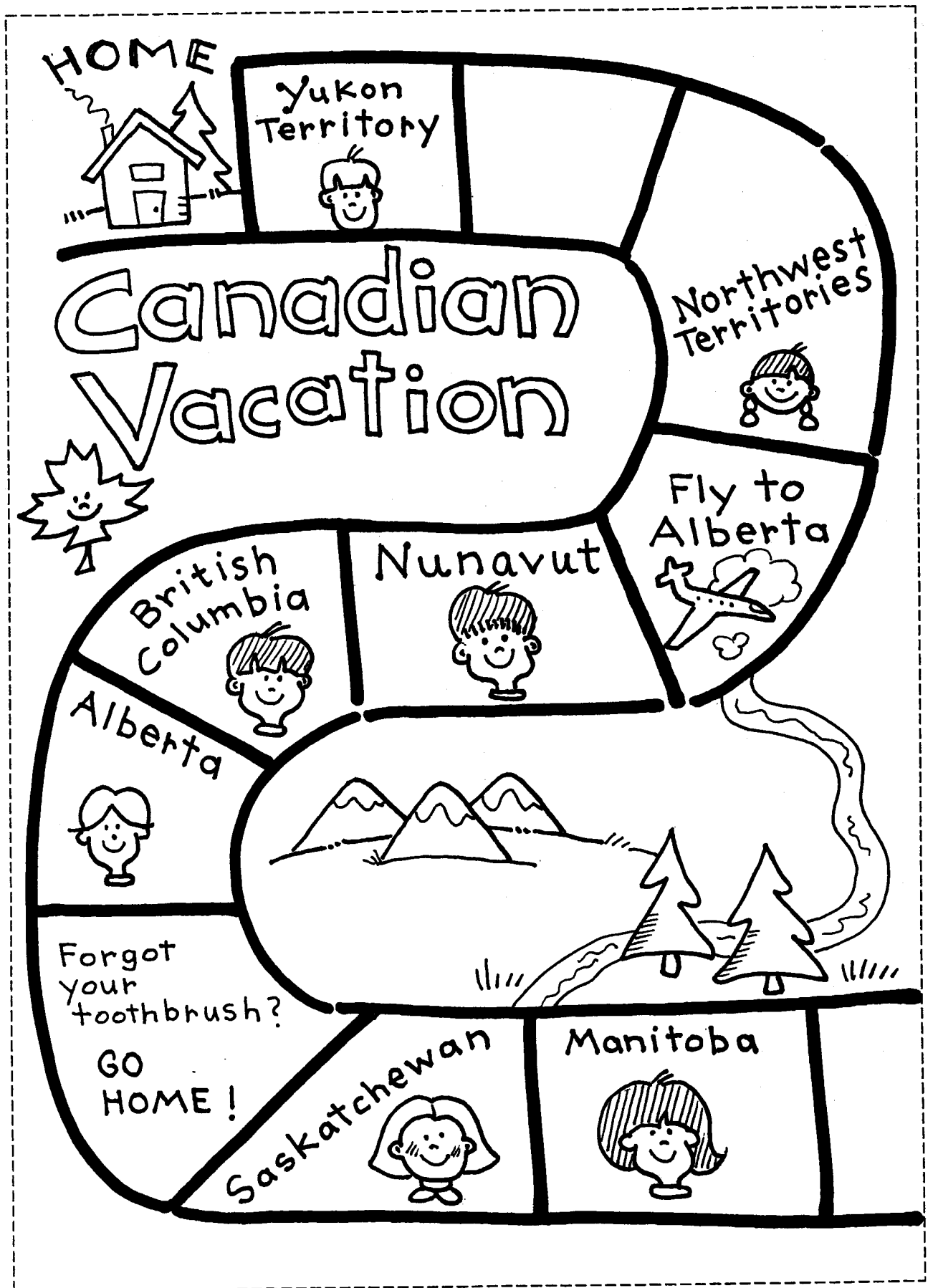
The object of the game: to collect as many province or territory cards as possible by landing on a square with a child on it.

For two players, you will need one die and a marker for each player. Lay out the province and territory cards face up beside the game board. There are two cards for each province and territory.

Roll the die to see who goes first. Roll the die and move your marker. If you land on a square with a child on it, pick up the matching province or territory card. See how many cards you can collect. If both cards are taken, the player cannot collect and waits for the next turn.

When you reach the end of the trail, turn around and go back home.

Have fun on your Canadian vacation.

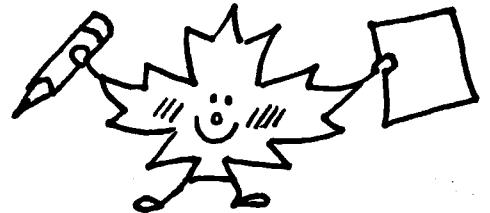
