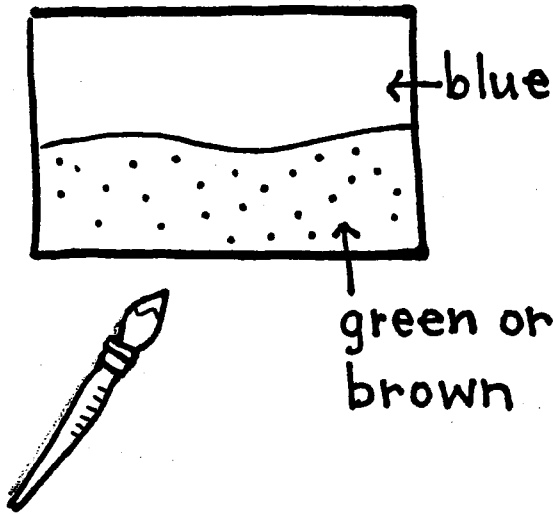
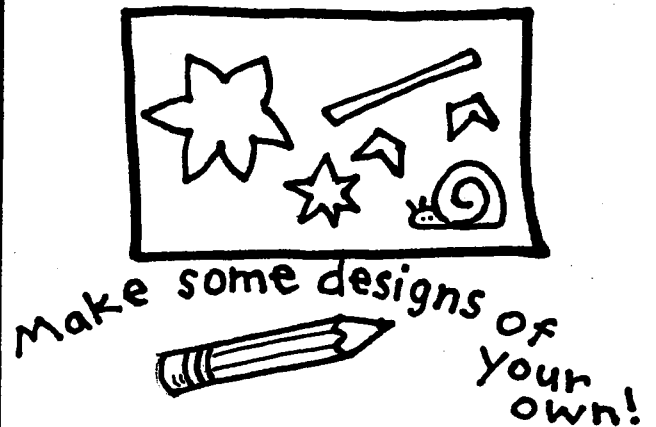


How to Make a Prairie Lily Collage

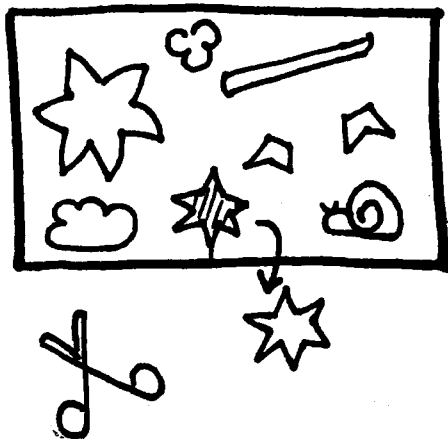
1. Paint a landscape on a large sheet of art paper. Let it dry.



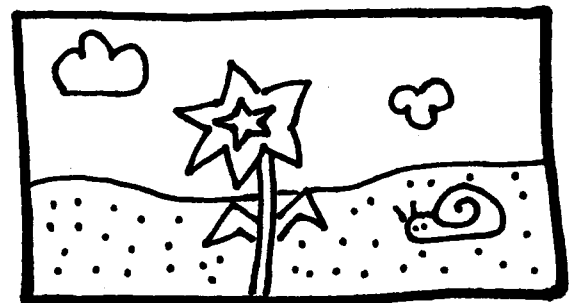
2. Trace the prairie lily patterns on another large sheet of art paper.

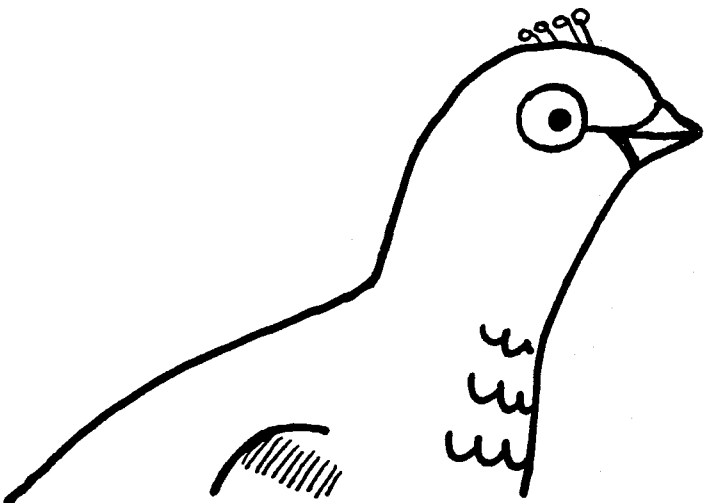
